


Important Requirement Reminder for Medicaid & Ambetter Notice of Pregnancy (NOP) Submission via the Secure Portal

As part of Home State Health's commitment to care management a Notice of Pregnancy (NOP) requirement was implemented January 1, 2018.

For Medicaid, a NOP form must be on file prior to reimbursement of obstetrical prenatal claims (E&M codes with/without TH modifier and/or obstetrical diagnosis code).


Key Information:

- NOP must be submitted at the first prenatal visit for your pregnant patient via the Home State Health portal (see below).
- Submission of the NOP allows Home State's care management team to coordinate the member's care and identify any possible high risk pregnancies.
- Our obstetric care management staff want to complement and support the care you provide to Home State Health members in your office.
- Patients can also submit a NOP for themselves via the Home State Health portal via their login.
