









## Home State Health Ophthalmology Provider Transition

Effective for service dates beginning January 1, 2021, **Home State Health will assume the management of medical eye care services delivered by ophthalmologists** for Home State Health, Ambetter from Home State Health, and Allwell from Home State Health.

Envolve Vision will continue to manage routine eye care services and full-scope of licensure optometric services for all Home State Health plans.

Home State Health will be responsible for the following functions for ophthalmologists providing medical eye care services beginning in January 1, 2021, to include:

- · Contracting, Credentialing
- · Claim Processing, Claim Appeals
- Provider Services
- Provider Partnership Management
- Provider Education and Resource Materials (Provider Manual, Training)
- Provider Web Portal
- Prior Authorization, Retrospective Utilization Review, Medical Necessity Appeals
- Provider Complaints
