Need a Breast Pump?

If you are pregnant or recently had a baby, you may be eligible to get a breast pump **at no cost** through your Home State Health and Show Me Healthy Kids benefits.

WHO CAN GET A BREAST PUMP?

You may be eligible if:

- You are pregnant
- You recently had a baby
- You are a current Home State Health or Show Me Healthy Kids member

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- You will need a prescription from your provider before your breast pump can be shipped.
- You can receive one breast pump per pregnancy, but no more than one every two years.
- You may choose any network vendor and contact that provider directly to place your order.
- Please choose only one vendor.
- You will not be reimbursed for a breast pump purchased at a retail store.
 - » Ordering from more than one vendor may result in extra charges that you could be responsible for.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY BREAST PUMP?

Breast pumps usually ship during your third trimester, once your prescription is received and your order is processed.
