





Important New Regulatory Requirement for Rural Health Clinics

Effective July 1, 2015, Independent Rural Health Clinics (IRHCs) and Provider Based Rural Health Clinics (PRHCs) must comply with MO HealthNet billing guidelines for services provided under agreements with Home State Health. For all dates of service July 1, 2015 and after the following billing guidelines will apply:

PBRHCs

- > Claims must be submitted on a UB-04
- > Type of Bill in field #4 must be 711

IRHCs

- Claims must be submitted on a UB-04
- Revenue code in field #42 must be 0521
- > Type of Bill in field #4 must be 715
- ➤ HCPC procedure code T1015 must be submitted in field #44
- > EPSDT/HCY Exam
 - HCPC procedure code T1015EP must be submitted in field #44
 - The 5-digit EPSDT/HCY screening code must be shown in Field #74.
 - V20.2 must be shown as the primary diagnosis in Field #67.

NOTE: All RHCs must bill on a UB-04 for all services provided on or after July 1, 2015

Compliance with regulatory requirements will ensure appropriate reimbursement under the state requirements. The reimbursements are as follows:

- ➤ PBRHCs will reimburse ninety percent (90%) of their allowable Medicaid billed charges.
- ➤ IRHCs will reimburse ninety percent (90%) of their Medicaid interim rate per visit.
