You have the best interests of your patients at heart — and you have their trust, too. Take these steps to help protect them from the flu:

- Make a strong recommendation to your patients to get their flu vaccine using a declarative statement.

 For example, say, "You're due for your flu vaccine.

 We'll do that at the end of your visit."
- Let your patients know that they can receive a flu vaccine at no cost through their doctor or a nearby pharmacy if they are a Home State Health, Show Me Healthy Kids, Ambetter, or Wellcare member.
- Consider creating standing orders so that others can vaccinate patients without your direct order.
- Follow-up with your patients to ensure they get vaccinated.
- Address any questions or concerns your patients have using the Ask-Tell-Ask model.
- Add a check-in about your patients' vaccine status after a routine event during each appointment.
