Aftercare and Transitional Treatment Foster Care (T-TFC) Plan Elements

Purpose: This checklist outlines key elements that providers should consider including in an Aftercare or Transitional Treatment Foster Care (T-TFC) plan. These components are essential to support continuity of care, facilitate long-term stability, and ensure the youth and their families have a well-coordinated transition from residential or TFC services back to the community.

Providers are encouraged to use this as a guide when developing individualized Aftercare or T-TFC plans to ensure all relevant medical, educational, behavioral, and family needs are addressed.
